Apart from the various core subject teachers, we have dynamic teachers for physical education, karate, robotics and dance. After the schools hours' children are encouraged to take part in Skating and Rifle Shooting. We have also introduced Music and Shloka this academic year. "Success is not final; Failure is not fatal: It is the courage to continue that counts"-The aim of S.J.E.S. Central School is nothing but excellent academic performance of students.

I proudly place before you the achievement of our students and progress of our school. Where all our staff members are committed and dedicated in achieving the excellence. The results of our 10th and 12th classes CBSE Board Examination are as follows:- We have achieved 100% results. Joshitha has topped in 10TH CBSE Examination. 68% students have passed with first division. T Rushil of Grade XII has secured the top most marks.

Vijayalakshmi has topped in SSLC Board Examination. We also have our PUC students who have secured the top marks in the board examination Tarani of PCMC, Chinmayi Bheema of PCMB, Sandhya of SEBA, Shravya from CEBA have topped in their respective streams.

We started our journey for the current Ay- on 20-5-2024. We have encouraged our students to take part in various events related to Literacy and Art- like Silverzone Olympiad for Mathematics, Science, English and General Knowledge. Various literacy competitions held by CBSE board, Spell Bee Competition, Science exhibition. Our students had an opportunity to visit the GPO located in Rajbhavan Road and learnt about all the bays in the GPO as a part of the educational tour.

Celebrations are sharing the happy moments together and spreading joy all around is a vital aspect of S J E S. We follow it every year religiously.

Our young super stars had show and tell activities on Pink day and Orange day. They were taken to a super market to enhance their knowledge and teach them the world beyond text books and classrooms, They were taken on a campus tour as a part of their activity based learning.
- b) SJES Central school also plays a major role in inculcating the values of great leaders and teaching them to keep their surroundings clean by observing the shiksha saptah week (7 days cleaning programme), our students have taken part in Indian Navy quiz, Har ghar Thiraga campaign was initiated, also the remembrance of Partition Horror day by inculcating the sense of patriotism, National Space Day was celebrated, Rashtriya Ekta Diwas, Bhagwan Birsa Divas, Indian Constitution was celebrated with a great zest.

SJES group of Institution provides an ample opportunity for their students to showcase their talents by motivating them to take part in various skill related events like Drawing and colouring competition, cooking without fire completion for both pre-primary and high school and also the science exhibition where the excellent science models were shortlisted and Asra Nissa of Grade IX took part in inter school competition and has secured second place for her innovative project- magical fingers and has also won cash prize.

The school looks at each learner as a unique whole person with special capabilities and unlimited potential by providing a conducive and encouraging environment. The students are learning STEM activities on a weekly basis in pre-primary classes.

Our Students from Grade 2-10 had taken part in various inter-school sports competitions Lohith N R has secured 5th place and Manish R has secured 7th place in Inter school chess competition out of 300 competitors.

Our Students Nandan and Yashwanth had taken part in district level Rifle shooting competition and were selected for state level competition and now Nandan is currently taking part in the National level competition which has begun on 18th and will go up to 25th of December.

Students of SJES have taken part in various Zonal, district level skating competitions and Darahas of Grade VII had taken part in 200 m Speed skating competition and has secured Bronze medal and has been selected for National level Speed skating competition.

Our students had also taken part in various karate competition held by Japan Shotokan karate academy and all our students have won the trophies where they have all secured the 1st place in kumite and katta competitions and they have also bagged the overall trophy out of 2000 participants. They had also taken part in International level karate competition held at shimoga and they secured 1st and 2nd places .

Our school organizes Educational and fun-filled trips every year to help students gain first-hand knowledge in augmenting their academic learning transacted beyond the confines of a class room, in joyful company of peer & friends. The Pre-primary and primary students enjoyed their fun filled trip to “Greenwood Resort”, whereas the high school students had been to Coorg.
